Valuation and Full Value Protection

Full valuation and FVP information is on the Bill of Lading. Please review Bill of Lading for complete details.

OPTION 1 - Full (Replacement) Value Protection

initial if OPTION 1

The Cost Estimate that you received includes Full (Replacement) Value Protection (FVP) for the articles that are included in your shipment. The coverage is based on a valuation amount equal to \$6.00 multiplied by the weight of your shipment, subject to a minimum valuation amount of \$6000. If you wish to declare a higher value for your shipment than the minimum amounts, it must be listed on the Bill of Lading.

OPTION 2 - WAIVER of Full (Replacement) Value Protection - \$0.60 (Sixty Cents) per Pound Coverage

initial if OPTION 2

This lower level of protection is provided at no additional cost. However, it provides only minimal protection that is considerably less than the average value of household goods. For example, the settlement for an audio component valued at \$1000 that weighs 10 pounds would \$6.00 (10 pounds times \$0.60).

Transportation of High Value or Special Items

initial

All items included in your shipment that are considered to be of extraordinary (unusual) value must be specifically identified and the carrier must be advised that they are included in the shipment. Items of extraordinary value are defined as those having a value greater than \$100 per pound. These items must be tendered to us prior to loading and an "Inventory of Items Valued in Excess of \$100 Per Pound Per Article" form must be completed. The mover's liability for loss of or damage to any article valued in excess of \$100 per pound will be limited to \$100 per pound unless identified on the inventory form.

Items Left Behind

initial

The mover cannot be held responsible for items left at residence after loading. It is your responsibility to make sure that nothing is left behind. Please make sure your check closets, cabinets, drawers, attics, neighbor's residence, basements, garage, and outside areas before signing documents. If an item is not loaded, you may be responsible for additional charges incurred to retrieve and deliver those items.

Property Damage

initial

Any property damage to residence at origin or destination must be so noted at time of loading or delivery.
